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Cost of riot insurance

RIOT insurance cover is available for domestic householders and private motorcar owners and is not expensive, Dr Louis Volks, a member of the SA Insurance Brokers' Association, said today.

There are two types of riot insurance, Dr Volks said. The first type, for non-politically motivated riot action, is available as an extension to normal motoring or householders policies.

Politically motivated riot cover can be had through a fund created by an Act of Parliament last year and administered by the South African Special Risks Insurance Association on similar lines to Motor Vehicle Act third party insurance.

He said cover for houses cost about 25c a R1000 over normal cover and for motorcars it cost R1 a year up to the value of

R15 000. Cars over that value could be insured at 0,05 percent.

The present riots have been declared non-political by the Commissioner of Police, General Mike Geldenhuys, who said yesterday that the Elsie's River riots were caused by 'skollie' elements and were divorced from the schools political action of the previous weeks.
