- A house can be insured for a rate of 0,030% a year annum — the premium on a house valued at R100 000 would be R30. The same rate applies to the contents of the
- Industial and commercial risks can be insured at 0,120%.

Mr Schneeberger chal-lenges criticism levelled at Sasria that it is unyielding: "This blatently overlooks the fact (hat Sasria is vulnerable to manipulation and exploi-tation. To maintain tight con-trol, our rules and regula-tions have to be stringent and we have had to enforce
